YEARS 5 & 6 CAMP LEVY ACCOUNT FOR 2025

CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSION FUND (CSEF) - 2024

Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) payment for expenses relating to Camps, Sport and/or Excursions is available for eligible families who hold a valid means-tested concession card.

Some common examples of school-organised programs for which the CSEF payment may be used include:
